

Storage:

Store in a cool dry place away from direct sunlight. Once opened reseal pack securely.

On newly dug ground where fouling has occurred, remove all signs and evidence and clean area. Apply granules at a rate of 20-30g/sqm.

Re-apply every three to five days until toilet training is successful.

Preventative territory marking training aid – apply by creating a small bead of approximately 0.5cm-1cm width around pots & planters.
